Barcelona, 11-13 June 2019

In the framework of Community Building and Capitalization activities of the GO SUMP project, a series of High Level Training Courses on Sustainable Mobility targeting Mediterranean Cities are being held with the aim of consolidating capacity building and promoting transferability of urban practices among the Interreg-MED Urban Transport Community (UTC) and Mediterranean stakeholders.

The topics which will focus on two key domains identified by the UTC and will be deployed in two parallel training courses, with a special focus on engaging south Mediterranean cities in transferring processes in order to promote more comprehensive sustainable mobility policies and practices.

1st High Level Training Course: “Financing Sustainable Mobility”

* Presentation of financing mechanisms and schemes for promoting sustainable city mobility (city taxes management, external financing schemes (EIB, Grants, etc.), GHG emission reduction and carbon credits, etc.)

2nd High Level Training Course: “The Mobility & Tourism Nexus”

* Methodologies and measures for mitigating the impact of tourism on urban mobility in Mediterranean cities.

Objectives of the Training Courses:

- >> Capacity Building in technical departments of Mediterranean cities in order to promote Sustainable Mobility practices and policies;
- >> Demonstrate projects’ solutions for the promotion of sustainable mobility models in the Mediterranean area;
- >> Bring together experts from the urban transport sector to explore synergies and share best practices and innovative ideas;
- >> Understand the current state of – including the challenges and the assets of – the urban transport sector in the Mediterranean area;
- >> Formulate recommendations for the improvement of the urban transports sector in the Mediterranean area.
