The Med4Waste is a 2-year-long capitalisation project (2021-2023) co-funded by the European Union under the ENI CBC Med programme. The project aimed to facilitate new governance models for integrated and efficient urban waste management policies across the Mediterranean, with particular emphasis on organic waste and circular economy. Listed here are the main achievements of the project, with a QR code so you can explore them at your convenience.

The **Med4ZeroWaste & Circular Economy Course** supports waste management practitioners in learning more about Circular Economy and Zero Waste Strategies. Created with content from Med4Waste capitalised projects, partners, and literature. The course is open to anyone interested and targeted to waste management stakeholders. The classroom is designed to be self-paced and self-assessed, and is hosted at Ubiqna platform. The course is and it will always be free of charge and it is available in English and in Arabic.



A **Catalogue of successful practices** on waste management with experiences from other ENI CBC Med projects. Contains an overview of successful practices, solutions and approaches in waste separation, collection, treatment, and recycling in the Mediterranean region. It also highlights the lessons-learnt that should be considered in replicating the practices. It is available in English, French, and Arabic.

A comprehensive **Business report** on Integrated Waste Management (IWM) and circular economy models, the report is centred on resource efficiency and climate-friendly practices. It provides a comprehensive overview of regulations, initiatives, and opportunities available to aspiring entrepreneurs in these countries.



The **Med4Waste Mentoring Scheme**: a program aimed to improve or develop the integrated municipal waste management (IMWM) plans of 6 selected cities; help them implement a tailored supporting actions; and promote the replication of successful actions being implemented in other projects from the ENI CBC-Med community through a twinning and exchange program.

The **Med4Waste Eco-Builder videogame**, designed with the succesful practicies of the capitalized projects, to increase awareness and knowledge about waste management in the mediterranean region, specially amongst young people (PC, Android and iOS versions available).



The **Policy Toolkit** collects the operational know-how of the project. It encompasses a set of recommendations and policy guidelines to promote and facilitate better governance for the implementation of a sustainable waste management and circular economy.
